An industrial engineer from Texas A&M University, Quiroga began his career at IBM before transitioning to politics. His rare combination of technical training, business insight, and political acumen has positioned him as a strategic voice in international conversations about Latin America’s future.

Quiroga is Vice President of the Club de Madrid, a member of the Inter-American Dialogue, and has led multiple election observation missions. He is a fierce defender of democratic values and a critic of authoritarian regimes in the region. His thought leadership spans from economic development and energy policy to climate change and political transitions.

In his keynote presentations, Quiroga delivers an unflinching analysis of Latin America's shifting landscape, offering practical insights and moral clarity. He challenges leaders to act boldly and ethically in navigating the complex challenges of governance, investment, and regional integration.
